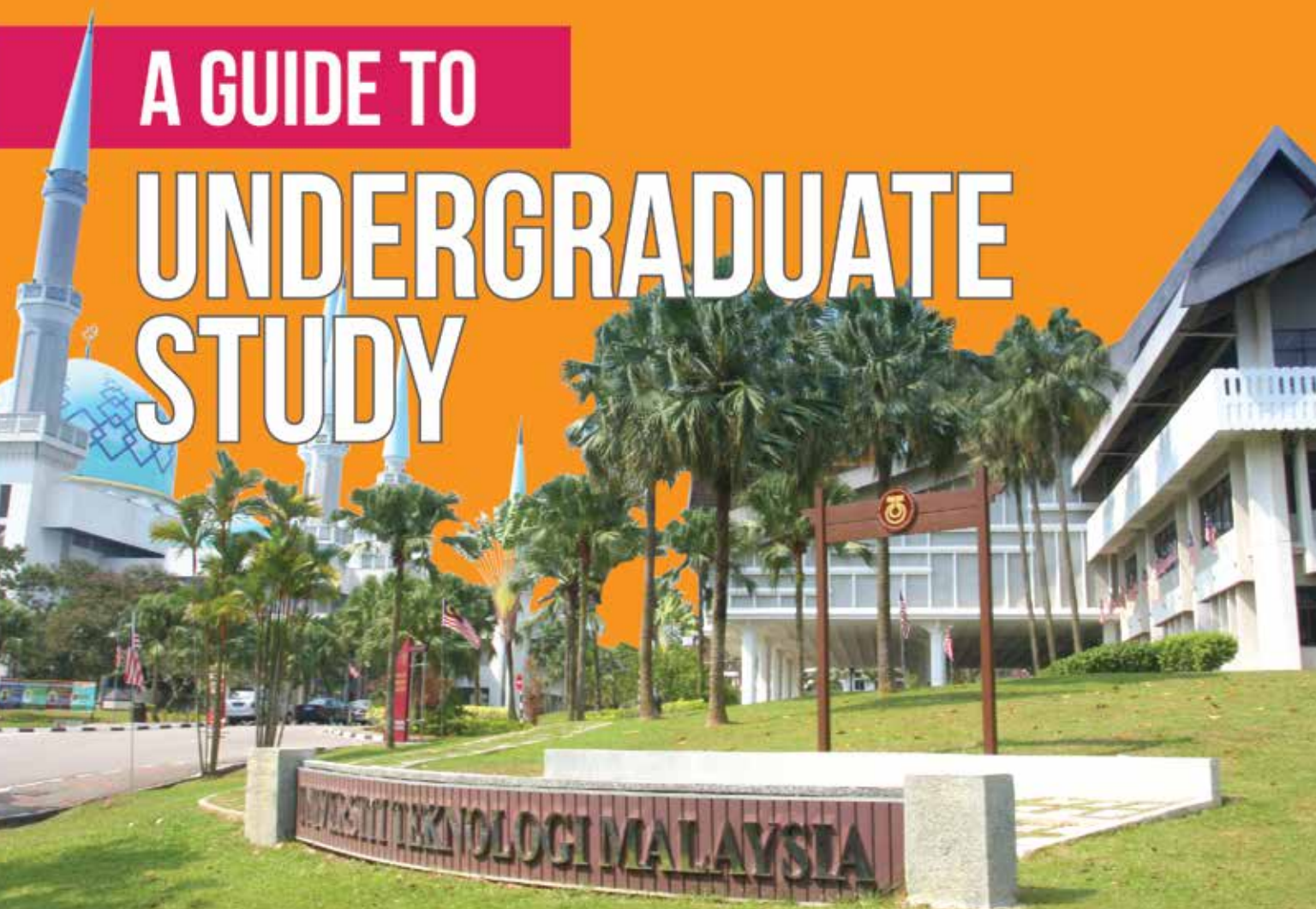

Cost of Living

The cost of living in Malaysia is lower than most developing countries. On top of the tuition fees, students need sufficient money to pay for accommodation, foods, books, travel, entertainment, telephone and other study-related expenses in Johor Bahru. Therefore, students need to plan carefully their expenses.

All students are guaranteed an in-campus accommodation. The overall expenses of living in campus are estimated between RM700-RM1200 per person per month (or USD200-USD350). This includes room, books, food, personal expenditure and travel within Johor Bahru. Cost will vary depending on personal requirement and lifestyle.

Student Visa

International students are required to have a student pass to study in Malaysia. UTM will assist international students in obtaining a visa and student pass. Visa and student pass requirements are subjected to change from time to time and varies among countries. All International students are advised apply for the Visa Referral Letter (VDR) from the respective Malaysian Embassy.
